GENERAL

This part applies to the provision of Intrastate Access Services.

Regulations, Rates and Charges applying to the provision of Access Services for Connection to Intrastate Communications Facilities for Intrastate Customers within the operating territory of Borderland Communications, LLC in the State of Michigan are as specified in the Borderland Communications, LLC Tariff F.C.C. No 1, Access Services, as it now exists, and as it may be revised, added to or supplemented.

Borderland Communications, LLC in providing Intrastate IntraLATA and Intrastate InterLATA communications retains Dial - 1+, and 0-Message Telecommunications Services (MTS).

Any rules and regulations relating to deposits, billing and payments, as specified elsewhere in this tariff, are subject to modification by M.P.S.C.

In those cases where the customer is unable, or does not, provide Percentage of Intrastate IntraLATA Use (PILU) as specified herein, the Telephone Company shall compute the PILU as a residual of the Percentage of Interstate Use (PIU) and Percentage of Intrastate InterLATA use (PIIU) reported by the customer.

Access Services are provided by means of wire, fiber optics, radio or any other suitable technology or a combination thereof.
