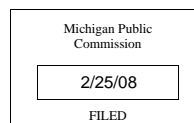

PRIMARY BASIC LOCAL EXCHANGE SERVICE

A. APPLICATION OF TARIFF

This Tariff applies to the provision of Primary Basic Local Exchange Service by Peninsula Telephone Company (Company) in the exchanges in Michigan designated in the Company's Tariff MPSC No. 1R, as may be amended from time to time.

The provision of Primary Basic Local Exchange Service is governed by the regulations contained in the Company's Tariff MPSC No. 1R, as may be amended from time to time, except as otherwise provided herein.

Primary Basic Local Exchange Service is only furnished in exchanges where the Company offers Residential Basic Local Exchange Service under its Tariff MPSC No. 1R, as may be amended from time to time, and is available for residential customers only.

Primary Basic Local Exchange Service is a stand-alone service that does not include any unregulated features.

B. LOCAL CALLING AREA

The Local Calling Area associated with Primary Basic Local Exchange Service consists of the following exchanges:

TRAVERSE CITY

Calls made to a telephone number with an NPA NXX that is associated with the rate center that is within the customer's local calling area are local calls regardless of the physical location of the called party.

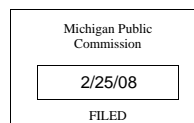

C. DESCRIPTION OF SERVICE

The Company provides Primary Basic Local Exchange Service at the rate below in Section D., and subject to the regulations contained in the Company's Tariff MPSC No. 1R.

Primary Basic Local Exchange Service is for voice only. Data calls are not allowed. Customers who use Primary Basic Local Exchange Service to make data calls will be notified of the need to switch to another calling plan that includes data calling.

Primary Basic Local Exchange Service provides an unlimited number of outgoing calls per month in calling to the Local Calling Area.

Primary Basic Local Exchange Service provides an unlimited number of outgoing minutes per month in calling to the Local Calling Area.

Primary Basic Local Exchange Service provides unlimited incoming local calls.

Touch Tone Service is included with this service.

Service Connection charges are governed by the Company's Tariff MPSC No. 1R.

A customer desiring to subscribe to Primary Basic Local Exchange Service must notify the Company.
