

LOCAL TELEPHONE EXCHANGE SERVICE

Exchange: SAND CREEK

A. GENERAL

1. The provision of service at the rates shown below is subject to the regulations given in the General Rules and Regulations as they now exist and are filed with and form part of this Tariff.
2. The rates shown below entitle the customer to call all stations bearing the designation of a central office of the following exchanges that comprise the Local Service Area:

SAND CREEK ADRIAN CLAYTON OGDEN CENTER LYONS, OHIO
HUDSON MORENICI BLISSFIELD

Sand Creek will block calls dialed 1-plus to stations within the Sand Creek, Adrian, Clayton, Ogden Center, Hudson, Morenci, Blissfield or Lyons, OH exchanges. Sand Creek will treat calls dialed without 1-plus to the Local Service Area as local calls and Sand Creek will bill those calls according to this tariff.

3. Calls made to a telephone number with an NPA NXX that is associated with the rate center that is within the customer's local calling area are local calls regardless of the physical location of the called party. (N)

Basic local exchange services installed after September 30, 2001 will include touchcall service at no additional charge above the rates listed for the class of service installed. Residence 1-Party lines in service at October 1, 2001, that did not have touchcall service as an auxiliary service at the end of business September 30, 2001 will receive a monthly credit of \$1.00 during the period that line is in continual service after September 30, 2001 and touchcall service is not affirmatively added as an auxiliary service. Business 1-Party lines and PBX trunks in service at October 1, 2001, that did not have touchcall service as an auxiliary service at the end of business September 30, 2001 will receive a monthly credit of \$1.00 during the period that line is in continual service after September 30, 2001 and touchcall service is not affirmatively added as an auxiliary service. If an end users action causes the disconnection of a line for any reason (such as nonpayment of a bill for regulated services, change of class of service or movement to vacation rate) that line will not qualify for any future touch call credit.
