

LOCAL TELEPHONE EXCHANGE SERVICE

Exchange: Deer Park

A. GENERAL:

1. The provision of service at the rates shown below is subject to the regulations given in the General Rules and Regulations as they now exist and are filed with and form part of this Tariff. (C)
2. The rates shown below (except for Semi-Public Service) entitle the customer to calls to all stations bearing the designation of a central office of the following exchanges, which compromise the Local Service Area: (C)
 - Zone 1 Deer Park (N)
 - Zone 2 All rate centers within the geographic boundaries of the 906 Area Code as of October 1, 2005 besides those included in Zone 1 (N)
3. The Company will Block 1-Plus Dialed Calls to Stations within the Local Service Area (except 8YY calls) (C)

C. EXCHANGE SERVICE AREA - Which is that area described as follows:

Commencing at the Southwest corner of Section 19, T47N, R12W, Columbus Township, Luce County, Michigan, east 28 miles, more or less, to the Southeast corner of Section 22, T47N, R8W, McMillan Township, Luce County, Michigan, thence north 2 miles to the Northeast corner of Section 15, T47N, R8W, thence east 2 miles to the Northeast corner of Section 13, T47N, R8W, thence north along the East line of Luce County, 6 miles to the Northeast corner of Section 13, T49N, R8W, thence west 2 miles to the Northwest corner of Section 14, T48N, R8W, thence north 3 miles to the Northwest corner of Section 35, T49N, R8W, thence east 2 miles to the Northeast Corner of Section 26, T49N, R8W, which corner is located on the East line of Luce County, thence northerly along the Luce County line to the shore of Lake Superior, thence westerly along the shore of Lake Superior to the intersections of Lake Superior and the West line of Luce County, thence south along the West line of Luce County to the place of beginning.
